(References: SB 317 (2024); HB 110 (2024); SB 301 (2024); SB 232 (2024); HB 31 (2023); HB 400 (2022); SB 251 (2026); SB 252 (2026))

RESPONSE Yes

State revenue generated from taxes should not be utilized for abortion or any other affiliated programs. The State Legislature needs to focus on protecting human life.
