READ THE ENDORSEMENT IN CONTEXT

An endorsement shows that an organization believes a candidate substantially aligns with its priorities; it does not prove agreement on every issue. This guide reports verified public endorsements, explains the organizations' stated positions, and identifies DFPC Action's biblical worldview analysis.

HOW TO READ THE BIBLICAL WORLDVIEW COLUMN

BIBLICAL STANDARD

Scripture teaches that government is instituted by God to administer justice, restrain evil, and promote what is good. This column therefore asks whether an organization's goals and methods honor God's design for human life and flourishing; marriage and family; parental responsibility; conscience and religious freedom; justice, stewardship, and public order. The red shading marks the biblical worldview analysis throughout the guide; it is not an indication of the extent of the organization's alignment with a biblical worldview. (Romans 13:1-4; Proverbs 29:2; Matthew 25:14-30.)

PUBLICATION NOTE *This is a reference guide, not a DFPC Action endorsement or candidate scorecard.*

VERIFICATION RULE

INCLUDED

Official organization releases or social accounts, plus candidate pages that expressly report an organization's endorsement.

EXCLUDED

Ratings, praise, donations, appearances, and recommendations unless the source expressly says 'endorsed.'

LIMITATION

The absence of a public list does not necessarily mean that no endorsement exists; it means that no verifiable record was located at the time of this guide's publication.

HONORING GOD WITH YOUR VOTE

WHY THE LENS MATTERS

Government is accountable to God to administer justice, restrain evil, and protect what is good. Christians therefore have a duty to be informed and to bring biblical truth to public life rather than surrendering moral judgment to a party or organization (Romans 13:1-4; 1 Peter 2:13-17).

AN INFORMED VOTER ASKS

- What worldview and priorities shape the endorsing organization?
- In addition to the endorsement, what does the candidate's record show about his or her worldview?

PROGRESSIVE ORGANIZATIONS

Organizations with a broad economic, social, criminal-justice, election, and institutional agenda.

1. Delaware Working Families Party PROGRESSIVE POLITICAL PARTY

WHERE THE ORGANIZATION STANDS

- Its Delaware platform supports universal abortion access, Medicaid funding for abortion, and nondiscrimination based on gender identity, gender expression, and sexual orientation.
- It also supports progressive taxation, replacing school police with counselors, shifting resources from law enforcement to social services, vote by mail, same-day registration, and Green New Deal policies, among others.

BIBLICAL WORLDVIEW ANALYSIS

- The platform's support for taxpayer-funded abortion rejects the protection Scripture gives to all human life, including the preborn. Its gender and sexuality policies also depart from God's design of humanity as male and female, and of marriage as the union of one man and one woman (Psalm 139:13-16; Genesis 1:27; Matthew 19:4-6).
- Its economic, policing, election, and health-care proposals should be measured by biblical duties to protect the vulnerable, preserve public order, respect stewardship and private ownership of property, honor productive work and personal responsibility, and examine real-world consequences. No political program should be assumed to be righteous simply because it seems to promise a compassionate result (Proverbs 31:8-9; Romans 13:1-4; Acts 5:4; 1 Thessalonians 4:11-12; 2 Thessalonians 3:6-12; Ephesians 4:28).

2. Delaware Democratic Socialists of America DEMOCRATIC SOCIALIST ORGANIZATION

WHERE THE ORGANIZATION STANDS

- Delaware DSA's bylaws identify it as a local chapter of the national Democratic Socialists of America, seek a transition to a democratic socialist society, reject the capitalist economic order, and call for resources and production to be controlled democratically and socially.
- National DSA states that its socialist vision draws in part on Marxism. Its current program calls for popular control of resources and production, economic planning, expanded public ownership, abortion access, queer liberation, and ending restrictions on gender expression and transition, marriage, divorce, and childraising.

BIBLICAL WORLDVIEW ANALYSIS

- Scripture requires generosity, justice for workers, and care for the poor, but it also affirms private stewardship, productive work, personal responsibility, and limits on civil power. An ideology that rejects the capitalist economic order and places broad control of resources and production in political structures should be tested against those duties and against the state's limited role in restraining wrongdoing (Acts 5:4; Ephesians 4:28; 1 Thessalonians 4:11-12; 2 Thessalonians 3:10-12; Romans 13:1-4).
- DSA's social program also conflicts with the biblical boundaries of sex, marriage, embodied male and female identity, and family authority. Treating abortion, gender transition, and the redefinition of marriage or childraising as liberation rejects God's design for human life and the family (Genesis 1:27; Genesis 2:24; Psalm 139:13-16; Matthew 19:4-6).

3. 314 Action PRO-SCIENCE DEMOCRATIC POLITICAL ORGANIZATION

WHERE THE ORGANIZATION STANDS

- 314 Action recruits, trains, and elects Democratic candidates with backgrounds in science, technology, engineering, mathematics, or medicine, and presents scientific training as a basis for evidence-driven government.
- Its political priorities include climate policy, abortion, and health-care access. It is a progressive electoral organization rather than a nonpartisan professional society.

BIBLICAL WORLDVIEW ANALYSIS

- Scientific evidence is a valuable tool for understanding creation and measuring consequences, but it cannot determine moral duties or the value of human life. The organization's abortion-rights advocacy conflicts with the duty to protect life in the womb (Psalm 139:13-16).
- Climate, health-care, and regulatory proposals should be tested through stewardship, justice, freedom, cost, and effectiveness. Calling a policy 'pro-science' does not place it above biblical moral evaluation.

REPRODUCTIVE-RIGHTS ORGANIZATIONS

Organizations that prioritize abortion access as their defining electoral priority.

4. Planned Parenthood Action Fund SEXUAL- AND REPRODUCTIVE-RIGHTS ADVOCACY

WHERE THE ORGANIZATION STANDS

- Its defining priorities include expanding abortion access, birth-control access, sexual and reproductive health care, and comprehensive inclusive sex education. It is legally distinct from Planned Parenthood's clinics.

BIBLICAL WORLDVIEW ANALYSIS

- Elective abortion intentionally ends innocent human life and conflicts with the duty of civil government to protect the vulnerable (Psalm 139:13-16; Proverbs 24:11; Luke 1:41-44).
- Its sex-education agenda also violates the biblical account of God's design for the body and sexuality, by normalizing sexual activity outside of marriage and teaching gender identity in ways that contradict biology and undermine parental authority (Genesis 1:27; Genesis 2:24; 1 Corinthians 6:18-20; Ephesians 6:1-4).

5. EMILY's List PRO-CHOICE DEMOCRATIC WOMEN'S ORGANIZATION

WHERE THE ORGANIZATION STANDS

- EMILY's List recruits, trains, funds, and supports Democratic women running for office who support abortion rights. Abortion support is central to its candidate identity and endorsement strategy.
- The organization also develops campaign strategy, fundraising capacity, voter research, persuasion, and turnout programs intended to elect its candidates and build Democratic governing majorities.

BIBLICAL WORLDVIEW ANALYSIS

- The problem is the pro-choice requirement: political support for elective abortion conflicts with the duty to defend innocent human life (Psalm 82:3-4; Psalm 139:13-16).
- An EMILY's List endorsement is strong evidence that the organization regards the candidate as aligned with abortion rights.

6. Reproductive Freedom for All REPRODUCTIVE-RIGHTS POLITICAL ORGANIZATION

WHERE THE ORGANIZATION STANDS

- Formerly NARAL Pro-Choice America, the organization mobilizes voters, lobbies lawmakers, supports ballot measures, and endorses candidates it calls reproductive-freedom champions.
- Its agenda includes abortion, contraception, and IVF; it also connects its work to LGBTQ+ rights and access to gender transitioning procedures, and voting requirements.

BIBLICAL WORLDVIEW ANALYSIS

- The organization treats abortion as a protected freedom rather than harm to unborn life, contrary to Scripture's teaching about human dignity before birth (Psalm 139:13-16; Jeremiah 1:5). Gender-transition advocacy also rejects the created reality of male and female (Genesis 1:27).
- The lack of regulations in IVF also raises many questions as to how human embryos are created, selected, stored, and destroyed. Human life is to be valued, at any stage.

7. Planned Parenthood of Delaware DELAWARE REPRODUCTIVE-HEALTH PROVIDER

WHERE THE ORGANIZATION STANDS

- The local 501(c)(3) affiliate operates Delaware health centers. Its listed services include contraception, abortion, STI care, prenatal care, miscarriage management, and gender-transition hormone therapy.
- It is legally distinct from Planned Parenthood Action Fund and its electoral committees. No separate current local Delaware endorsement slate was located for this edition, although the affiliate has made endorsements in past cycles.

BIBLICAL WORLDVIEW ANALYSIS

- Elective abortion ends innocent human life, while medical interventions that reject the body's male-female reality depart from God's design for the person (Psalm 139:13-16; Genesis 1:27).

CURRENT STATUS No separate 2026 Delaware affiliate endorsement slate located; only the national Action Fund's formal endorsements are currently listed.

LGBTQAI+ ORGANIZATIONS

Organizations focused on LGBTQAI+ political activity, representation, and policy.

8. Delaware Stonewall PAC LGBTQ+ POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEE

WHERE THE ORGANIZATION STANDS

- Stonewall PAC describes itself as Delaware's political voice for the LGBTQ+ community and works to elect candidates who advance equality, fairness, opportunity, and full LGBTQ+ inclusion.

BIBLICAL WORLDVIEW ANALYSIS

- Every person bears God's image and must be treated with dignity; harassment or unjust violence is wrong (Genesis 1:27; James 3:9).
- The conflict with biblical worldview arises when 'full inclusion' requires government or schools to affirm gender identity or sexual relationships contrary to biblical teaching on male and female, marriage, and sexual conduct, or penalizes parents and ministries that hold those beliefs (Genesis 2:24; Matthew 19:4-6; Ephesians 6:1-4).

9. LGBTQ+ Victory Fund LGBTQ+ CANDIDATE ORGANIZATION

WHERE THE ORGANIZATION STANDS

- Victory Fund recruits, vets, endorses, and funds openly LGBTQ+ candidates in order to increase LGBTQ+ representation at every level of government.
- Its endorsement standards require a candidate to be openly LGBTQ+, support full LGBTQ+ equality and bodily autonomy, demonstrate community support, and present a viable path to win. The organization describes its candidates as pro-equality and pro-choice (abortion).

BIBLICAL WORLDVIEW ANALYSIS

- Equal human dignity and fair treatment are biblical obligations. The conflict arises when 'full equality' and bodily autonomy require affirmation of sexual relationships, gender identity, or abortion that DFPC Action Scripture does not permit (Genesis 1:27; Matthew 19:4-6; Psalm 139:13-16).
- A Victory Fund endorsement is strong evidence of alignment with those threshold criteria.
