RESPONSE Yes

I supported SB 252 because I believe every woman should have the opportunity to view an ultrasound and receive important medical information before making a life-altering decision. I also support policies that prohibit taxpayer funding of abortion, ensuring Delawareans are not compelled to financially support a practice that many sincerely oppose on moral or religious grounds.
