1 1. Do you support legislation that protects preborn human life from abortion, including prohibiting taxpayer funding, and rejecting abortion as a right in the Delaware State Constitution? (References: SB 317 (2024); HB 110 (2024); SB 301 (2024); SB 232 (2024); HB 31 (2023); HB 400 (2022); SB 251 (2026); SB 252 (2026))

RESPONSE Yes

As a God Fearing Christian Man I believe emphatically in Pro Life and believe life starts at conception

2 2. Do you support legislation that holds the abortion industry accountable and liable for medical malpractice, negligence in providing informed consent, and removing the safeguards meant to protect women? (References: SB 252 (2026); HB 31 (2021); HB 400 (2022), HB 320 (2022); SB 301 (2024))

RESPONSE Yes

Yes. I support holding the abortion industry fully accountable for malpractice, negligence, failures of informed consent, and the removal of safeguards intended to protect women. Women deserve honest information, safe medical care, and access to the same legal protections available to every other patient. No abortion provider should be above the law

3 3. Do you oppose legalized assisted suicide and attempts to expand it? (References: HB 140 (2024))

RESPONSE Yes

I oppose Delaware's legalization through HB 140 which has already been passed and would support fully reversing it

4 4. Do you support amending the Delaware Constitution to explicitly protect the fundamental right of parents to direct the upbringing, education, and care of their children? (References: HB 319 (2022))

RESPONSE Yes

Yes. Parents have the God-given and fundamental right and responsibility to direct the upbringing, education, and care of their children. I support amending the Delaware Constitution to protect parents from unnecessary government intrusion, require transparency from schools and state agencies, and ensure that parents - not bureaucrats - remain the primary decision-makers for their children. This protection should never excuse abuse or neglect, but it should firmly safeguard the role of loving, responsible parents.

5 5. Do you support holding medical providers legally accountable and liable for performing experimental, permanent, or irreversible medical interventions on minors that interrupt and pause puberty, introduce cross sex hormones, and amputate body parts? (References: HB 346 (2024); SB 55 (2025))

RESPONSE Yes

Yes. I support holding medical providers fully accountable for performing permanent, irreversible, or experimental gender-transition interventions on minors. Children should not be subjected to puberty blockers, cross-sex hormones, or surgeries that remove healthy body parts, and providers should not receive special immunity from liability. I would support protecting minors, preserving parental rights, requiring full informed consent, and giving harmed patients and families meaningful legal recourse.

6 6. Do you support legislation that protects the fundamental rights of children to know and be known by their biological mother and father, prohibits changing a child's sex on their birth certificate, and protects family biological connection between parents and children? (References: SB 250 (2026); HB 375 (2026))

RESPONSE Yes

Yes. Children have a fundamental right to know and, when safe and appropriate, be known by their biological mother and father. I support preserving biological truth on birth certificates, protecting the biological connection between parents and children, and preventing government policies from erasing or obscuring a child's sex or family origins. These protections should include carefully defined exceptions for adoption, donor conception, surrogacy, abuse, and the safety of the child.

7 7. Do you oppose policies that embed sexually explicit material and comprehensive sexuality frameworks into school libraries and public school curricula, particularly when they conflict with obscenity laws, parental rights, or religious beliefs? (References: HB 199 (2021); SB 97 (2024); HB 119 (2025); SCR 156 (2026))

RESPONSE Yes

Yes. I oppose embedding sexually explicit material or comprehensive sexuality frameworks in school libraries and curricula when they conflict with obscenity laws, parental rights, or religious convictions. Parents - not government officials or school bureaucrats - should decide what is appropriate for their children. I support age-appropriate health and safety instruction, but also full curriculum transparency, meaningful parental consent and opt-out rights, strong library safeguards, and the removal of obscene or sexually explicit material from children's access.

8 8. Do you support legislation that preserves sex-based protections in athletics to ensure fairness, safety, and equal opportunity for female athletes? (References: SB 191 (2024); SB 215 (2026))

RESPONSE Yes

Yes. I support protecting sex-based athletic categories to preserve fairness, safety, privacy, and equal opportunity for female athletes. Girls and women deserve a level playing field and should not lose opportunities, scholarships, records, or recognition because biological sex is disregarded in sports. I support separate male and female teams, reasonable coed options where appropriate, and policies that allow every student to participate while protecting women's athletics.

Do you support protecting individuals, churches, schools, and faith-based ministries from government penalties when operating according to sincerely held religious beliefs regarding sexuality, marriage, and human life? (References: HB 199 (2021); HB 74 (2023); HB 275 (2024); SB 169 (2021); SB 100 (2025); HB 37 (2025))

RESPONSE

Yes

Yes. I support protecting individuals, churches, religious schools, and faith-based ministries from government penalties, loss of funding, or compelled participation when they operate according to sincerely held religious beliefs regarding sexuality, marriage, and human life. Religious liberty protects not only worship but also the ability to live out one's faith in public life and service. I would oppose compelled speech, compelled participation, and government discrimination against people of faith, while continuing to enforce laws against violence, threats, harassment, and abuse.

RESPONSE

Yes

Yes. I support protecting free speech, religious expression, peaceful protest, and public advocacy in Delaware. Citizens, churches, schools, and organizations should not face criminal penalties simply for expressing sincere beliefs or advocating for public policies. Criminal law should target physical violence, true threats, force, coercion, and other unlawful conduct - not peaceful speech or religious viewpoints. I would oppose censorship, viewpoint discrimination, compelled speech, and retaliatory lawsuits designed to silence the people.
